School Fees

Collection of school fess will take place via Permission Click. More information to come the first week of school. Fieldtrips will be paid for as they arise via Permission Click.

Student Fee

\$35.00 (for grades K-9)

Covers the cost of lock, agenda book, and supplies.

Program Fee

\$15.00 (for grades 7-9)

Covers additional costs in Art, Band, Industrial Arts, and Option courses. *Band instrument rentals are an additional cost.

Building Access, Entrance and Exit Information

- All school doors will be locked during the day.
- Visitors must enter through the front door. Please ring the doorbell located on the wall to the right of the main doors to be granted access.
- Before and After School: Please drop off your child between 8:30 and 8:40 AM to ensure your child is in their class for 8:45 AM. Please be available to pick up your child by 3:20 PM daily.
- Students can enter the school at the 8:35 bell and should enter through the following doors:
 - Daycare Entrance: Kindergarten, Gr 1/2 Palka and Gr 2/3 Curry Students
 - Garden Doors: Gr 3/4 Lui, Gr 4/5 Kemp and Gr 6 McGregor Students
 - Front Doors: Grade 7 to 9 Students
- Parents and guardians must wait outside when dropping off or picking up their child.
- Back Lane Drop-Off (Stop, Drop, and Go): We ask parents to stop at the back lane entrance off Daniel Street, drop your child off where they will be greeted by our welcome committee who will assist them in walking across the field to their designated doors, and go on your way.
 - The back lane is one-way traffic between the hours of 8:00 AM to 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM to 4:00 PM.
 - Access to the back lane is only available between 9:00 AM and 4:00 PM.
 - Only General Byng staff, Prairie Children's Daycare staff and families will be granted access to the back lane between the hours of 8:00 AM and 9:00 AM
 - Please be mindful of the City of Winnipeg sign that restricts access via Beaumont Street into the back lane between the hours of 8:00 AM to 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM to 4:00 PM as well as some of our neighbours who may need to exit their homes during these times.
- **Walking and Biking:** We have the good fortune for our families to live in this accessible community. We encourage families to walk or bike to and from school. Please ensure bikes are locked up on the bike rack. Let the office staff know if you need to borrow a lock or tire pump.

Absences and Late Arrivals

- If a student will be away from school, please call the school office (204-452-3040), email us at <u>gbattendance@pembinatrails.ca</u>, or leave a message in Edsby.
- If a student is late for school (arriving after 8:45 AM or in the afternoon after 1:50 PM), the student is to come to the main school doors to access the building. Please ring the doorbell as the school doors will be locked.

School Supplies, Lockers and Cubbies

• School supplies have been purchased and will be given to students in Kindergarten through Grade 9 during the first week of classes.

Please send the following items with your child:

- o a backpack for materials from home
- o a water bottle
- a pair of earbuds / earphones
- Grades K-6 a pair of indoor runners
- o Grades 3-9 Physical Education: drawstring bag, one pair of gym shorts, one t-shirt

Lunch Program / Nutrition Break / Breakfast Program

- Nutrition Break will occur at 10:20. Please send a healthy snack for this break.
- There will be supervised eating and outdoor times for classrooms.
- Lunch program registration forms will be emailed via Permission Click during the first week of September.
- Lunch hour will occur as follows:
 - o 12:45 1:15 Grade 1-9 students eat lunch in their classroom
 - o 1:15 1:45 Grade 1-9 students outside
- The sharing of food/snacks is prohibited.
- Students not attending General Byng's Lunch Program must be off school grounds from 12:45-1:45.
- Breakfast Program information will be sent through email the first week of September.
- General Byng is a peanut and nut aware school. Please attempt to provide lunches and snacks that are nut free.
