ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEES

The Board of Trustees authorizes the Superintendent to establish permanent or ad hoc committees as necessary for the proper administration of Board policies and for the improvement of the educational program.

The membership, composition, and responsibilities of such committees will be defined by the Superintendent and may be changed as appropriate. In order that each group may work as effectively as possible, the Superintendent will explain clearly the group's function, responsibility, and the way it should make its recommendations. Authority for establishing policy, however, remains with the Board, and authority for implementing policy remains with the Superintendent.
