STATUTORY DEFINITIONS

- 1. **Personal information** means recorded information about an identifiable individual that relates to:
 - a) the individual's name;
 - b) the individual's home address or home telephone facsimile or email address;
 - c) information about the individual's age, sex, sexual orientation, marital or family status;
 - d) information about the individual's ancestry, race, colour, nationality or national or ethnic origin;
 - e) information about the individual's religion or creed or religious belief, association or activity:
 - f) personal health information about the individual:
 - g) the individual's blood type, fingerprints or other hereditary characteristics;
 - h) information about the individual's political belief or association or activity;
 - i) information about the individual's education, employment/occupation or occupational history;
 - j) information about the individual's source of income or financial circumstances, activities or history;
 - k) information about the individual's criminal history including regulatory offences;
 - I) the individual's own personal views or opinions, except if they are about another person;
 - m) the views or opinions expressed about the individual by another person, and
 - n) an identifying number, symbol or other particular assigned to the individual.
- 2. Personal health information means recorded information about an identifiable individual that relates to:
 - a) the individual's health or health care history, including genetic information about the individual;
 - b) the provision of health care to the individual, or
 - c) payment for health care provided to the individual, and includes
 - d) the PHIN as defined in the Personal Health Information Act and any other identifying number, symbol or particular assigned to an individual, and
 - e) any identifying information about the individual that is collected in the course of, and is incidental to, the provision of health care or payment for health care.
