

STUDENT ACCIDENT AND SUPPLEMENTAL MEDICAL INSURANCE

The Board recommends that parents consider purchasing student accident insurance to cover medical expenses, dental, disability, dismemberment or accidental death. The Board will provide information when available to parents with respect to Student Accident Insurance Plans.

Obtaining adequate student accident insurance is the responsibility of the participant and / or the parent(s)/guardian(s). Participants bear the financial responsibility for any costs associated with an accidental injury. The Pembina Trails School Division may carry insurance providing coverage in connection with student accidents on a limited basis in certain circumstances.

The Board strongly recommends that Student Accident Insurance be obtained by the parents of students participating in all school-sponsored trips within or outside Manitoba.

For out-of-province school-sponsored trips supplemental medical insurance is recommended. For out-of-country school sponsored trips the Board requires that Special Travel Health coverage be obtained. This coverage shall be a condition of final approval of any such trip and at a cost to the participants.
