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STAFF INTERACTION WITH STUDENTS

The Board expects the entire staff to strive to set the kind of example for students that will serve them well in their own conduct and behavior and contribute toward a school atmosphere that is friendly and respectful. All employees, volunteers, and members of the public, are expected to model respectful and ethical behavior in their conduct with students.

Interactions and relationships between staff and students should be based upon mutual respect, trust and an understanding of the appropriate boundaries between adults and students in an educational setting. The educational setting, for the purpose of this policy, includes approved curricular and co-curricular activities and the transportation of students participating in these activities. It is recognized that staff may participate in interactions outside of the educational setting such as those arising in the course of family or community social functions or activities which include parental supervision or consent.

Staff members shall be expected to regard each student as an individual and to accord each the rights and respect due any individual. Students and staff should treat each other with courtesy and consideration.
