

STUDENTS OF LEGAL AGE

Every student who has attained the age of majority, eighteen (18) years of age or older, shall be deemed to be an adult. Such students, like all other students who register within a school in the Division, shall be subject to and comply with the rules and regulations established for that school and the Division.

As provided for in JRCA and in accordance with The Public Schools Act, Section 42.3(3), the school shall not disclose to a parent the pupil file of a student who has attained the age of majority, eighteen (18) years, without first obtaining the consent of the student, supported by the completion of form JRCA-E.
