

STUDENTS WITH SPECIAL HEALTH NEEDS

The health and safety of all students is a primary concern of the Division. In emergency situations involving accident or illness, Division employees are expected to render first-aid and life-sustaining care to the extent of their knowledge and training, utilize emergency medical resources available in the community, and seek assistance of trained school personnel or other staff members.

Health Care Plans (HCP)

Health Care Plans (HCP) are developed when student needs meet the Unified Referral and Intake System (URIS) guidelines. A HCP shall be prepared and reviewed at least annually or when there is a change in the student's medical status. The nurse, school personnel, and the parent/guardian shall be involved in the preparation of the HCP and may consult the student's physician when needed.

The HCP shall describe the special health needs of the student and the plan for addressing those needs in the school setting. Appropriate training will be provided by the nurse to staff directly involved with the student.
