Pembina Trails Teachers' Association -2017-18 Draft Budget

(DELEGATIONS) (Issue #20170217001) B. Mauthe, President of the Pembina Trails Teachers' Association made a verbal presentation to the Board.

He said that the Division was faced with a reduction in the Provincial Funding of Schools Program of \$940,000 for the 2017/18 Budget compared to the 2016/17 Budget. He recognizes that the Board has commitments to increased costs through the collective agreements. He applauded the Board on the 2017/18 Draft Budget by not cutting programs and even adding a couple of programs and increasing the number of teachers due to the projected growth. He said that he has some concern with the reduction in the number of Educational Assistants and said that they provide valuable contribution to the success of students and teachers. He said that the Division is ensuring that class sizes remain manageable which helps students who need services will get the services. He said that the Division has had the courage to require the taxpayer to bear more of the cost so that students can continue to benefit.

## Right At School

(BUSINESS FROM PREVIOUS COMMITTEE MEETING OF THE WHOLE) (Issue #20170223006) In response to a question from D. Zuk, the Superintendent explained that the Right At School program from the United States provides curriculum enrichment in a before and after school setting. He said that Principals and the Board have met with the Right At School representatives. He said that a survey was sent to parents to solicit interest in this program. He said that this is not a Division run program but a program run by Right At School. He said that the Division is allowing Right At School to provide a service to parents who choose to take advantage of the program. D. Zuk said that she had some concerns but the support from the principals for this service gives some comfort to enable her to support this program.

In response to a question from D. Zuk, the Superintendent said that he will communicate with the principals and Right At School in schools where appropriate. Right at School said that they support students who cannot afford the service, and from the revenue to be received by the Division, a portion could be put into a bursary fund to support students. The Superintendent said that a recommendation will be brought forth to the Board for a decision with respect to revenue disposition. He said that Provincial Government officials are aware of this possible initiative and are supportive. He said that staff with questions can contact their Senior Administration links. Right At School will be organizing communication and details.
