- Reflect and learn about yourself - build self-awareness
- Help you to understand how to become more successful at school
- Understand your strengths and the connections to jobs/careers

Step A – Sign Up to Create a myBlueprint Account

(Note: Please use **Google Chrome** when using this website)

- 1) Go to www.myBlueprint.ca/pembinatrails
- 2) Click **Sign-up** to create an account
- 3) Please choose your **High School** from the list or **Grades 7, 8, 9** from the drop down box and then click **Create Account**
- 4) Click on **Student** as the account type. Choose the **current grade** you are in, then click **Continue**
- 5) Complete the section titled **personal info**.
Please make sure to provide an email address that you can access at the school in order to verify your account afterwards.
- 6) You will create a **username** and **password** so that you can sign in at a later date. Record your username and password below.

Step B – Getting Ready for the Learning Styles Survey

3) What do you think are the best ways for you to study and

prepare for a test or a quiz? Explain

Step C - Completing the Learning Styles Survey

- 1) Open your my Blueprint account:
 - a) open **Google Chrome**
 - b) In the URL type in www.myblueprint.ca/pembinatrails
 - c) Type in your **username email** and **password**
 - d) Click **Log In**

- 2) On the left side menu, click on **Who Am I**

You will be asked 20 questions that will help the program to learn about you. It is very important that you read the questions carefully and answer them honestly for the program to learn about you.

There are no right or wrong answers – Take your time!

- 3) Click on the **Learning Styles Survey** and complete the 20 question survey.
- 4) Now that you have finished the survey, list your 3 learning styles and the % for each.

Step D - Learning Styles Survey Reflection

Step E – Getting Ready for the Personality Survey

You are a unique individual, yet we all have personality traits that are similar to others. Learning about your personality type helps you to: understand what drives your thinking and behaviour and helps you to appreciate the diversity/differences that exist in other people. Share what you already know about your personality by answering these 3 questions.

- 1) Some people like being at the “centre of attention” while others prefer to remain in the background in crowds. How do you feel this relates to you and your personality?

- 2) When making big decisions, some people use “how they feel” to help make their decisions, while other people “think carefully” before making those decisions. How about you?

- 3) Some people prefer strict deadlines while other people might desire more flexibility with due dates and timelines. How does this relate to you? Explain.

4) Step F – Completing the Personality Type Survey

1) Open your my Blueprint account:

- a) open **Google Chrome**
- b) In the URL type in www.myblueprint.ca/pembinatrails
- c) Type in your **username email** and **password**
- d) Click **Log In**

2) On the left side menu, click on **Who Am I**

You will be asked 40 questions that will help the program to learn about you. It is very important that you read the questions carefully and answer them honestly for the program to learn about you.

There are no right or wrong answers – Take your time!

3) Click on the **Personality Survey** and complete the 40 question survey.

4) Now that you have finished the survey, list your **4 letter combination** that connects to your personality.

5) What **WORDS** do those letters represent or mean?

Step G – Personality Type Survey Reflection

- 1) Read through the **OVERVIEW** the survey has provided you about your personality type. Choose 4 or 5 items from that **OVERVIEW** shared and list them below.

- 2) Click on **VIEW MORE**. Explore this information. What is this information saying about your personality? Explain.

Step H – Getting Ready for the Interests Survey

What captures your interest? When you're doing things you enjoy and are interested in, you'll likely be happier and more successful in life. This next survey will help you to better understand your interests and how these interests which could help guide the choices you make for jobs/occupations in your future. Share what you already know about your interests by answering these questions.

- 1) Some people enjoy creative expression (changing the way they dress, their hair, creating artwork without instructions, using their ideas to design things) while other people are more interested in having guidelines to follow and following directions that are given to them) **How does this relate to you?**

- 2) Some people are more interested in working by themselves while others prefer to spend their day connecting with people. **How does this relate to you?**

Step I – Completing the Interests Survey

- 3) Log back in to your my Blueprint account:
 - a. open **Google Chrome**
 - b. In the URL type in www.myblueprint.ca/pembinatrails
 - c. Type in your **username email** and **password**
 - d. Click **Log In**

- 4) On the left side menu, click on **Who Am I**

You will be asked 48 questions that will help the program to learn about you. It is very important that you read the questions carefully and answer them honestly for the program to learn about you.

There are no right or wrong answers – Take your time!

- 5) Click on the **Interest Survey** and complete the 48 question survey.
- 6) Upon finishing the survey, you will be provided with a name for your “**interest type**.” List the name of your **interest type** below.

Step K – Getting Ready for the Knowledge Survey

- 1) Log back in to your my Blueprint account:
 - a. open **Google Chrome**
 - b. In the URL type in www.myblueprint.ca/pembinatrails
 - c. Type in your **username email** and **password**
 - d. Click **Log In**

- 2) On the left side menu, click on **Who Am I**

You will be asked 30 questions that will help the program to learn about you. It is very important that you read the questions carefully and answer them honestly for the program to learn about you.

There are no right or wrong answers – Take your time!

- 3) Click on the **Knowledge Survey** and complete the 30 question survey.

- 4) Now that you have finished the survey, list the **top subject area** that was identified for you. _____


